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What is it?


Working with DHCS, Office of Health Information Technology on a secure, web based Provider Portal to support the enrollment and submission of required ARRA/HITECH information necessary for eligible providers and hospitals to receive the available EHR incentive dollars.

There are many more detailed requirements, but at a high level, hospitals with a minimum of 10% Medi-Cal discharges and providers with a minimum of 30% Medi-Cal (20% for pediatricians) encounters are eligible to receive those incentive payments (possible millions for hospitals or \$63,500 for providers) upon the adoption, implementation, upgrade and meaningful use of certified Electronic Health Record systems over the programs lifespan.



To obtain a CMS EHR Certification ID, follow the steps outlined below:

- Select your practice type by selecting the Ambulatory or Inpatient buttons below
- Search for EHR Products by browsing all products, searching by product name or searching by criteria met
- Add product(s) to your cart to determine if your product(s) meet 100% of the required criteria
- Request a CMS EHR Certification ID for CMS registration or attestation from your cart page

STEP 1: SELECT YOUR PRACTICE TYPE

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Use the browse all products, search by product name or search by criteria met to search for certified EHR products.

STEP 3: ADD PRODUCTS TO YOUR CART

To add products to your cart, select the "Add to Cart" link in the far-right column. After adding a product to your cart, you will be directed to your cart page. Once on the cart page you can view the criteria met by the product(s) in your cart. Once the product(s) in your cart meet 100% of the required criteria, you can obtain a CMS EHR Certification ID.

You can sort on any column in the table below. To sort, click on the column header and the arrow will confirm you are sorting in ascending or descending order.

About Product Classifications

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Workflow

What do I need to submit:

- Eligibility Data on Visits for 2011 Incentive Payment
 - EH - 10/01/09 to 09/30/2010 (10% Discharges)
 - EP - 01/01/10 to 12/31/2010 (30% Encounters)
- EH will need to submit prior year Cost Report data, including attaching relevant pages within SLR
- Copy of complete contract or relevant portions of contract with EHR Vendor (will attach with submission)
- Screen Shot of ONC site to include Certification Number and associated product(s)
- Print, Sign, Scan and attach attestation prior to 11/30/12 for EH and 02/29/12 for EP for the 2011 Incentive
